



The Regional Director of Education of Epirus, Angeliki Foteinou has a main degree in Medieval and Modern Greek Studies (MMGS) and she also holds a second degree in Philosophy, Pedagogy and Psychology, of the University of Ioannina.

She has been working as a teacher of Literature for 20 continuous years in public secondary education schools.
