

The Regional Directorate of Primary & Secondary Education of Epirus participates as a partner organization in a two years Erasmus + KA201 program, from 2018 to 2020, entitled "Integration of Museums into School Education".

In the specific project, our institution co-operates with the corresponding Directorate of Education of Konya, in Turkey, which is the coordinator of the project, along with six other organizations, from Italy, Poland, Slovenia, Greece and two others from Spain.

Teachers from the 5th High School in Ioannina as well as the Silversmithing Museum participate in project implementation activities.

The aim of the project is to emphasize the role of the museum as a pedagogical approach and to carry out innovative activities that will motivate the recognition of the value of museum exhibits as an alternative, interdisciplinary source of learning for pupils aged 10 to 15 years old.

Participating teachers will attend two transnational Learning Teaching Activities including the following topics:

1. The promotion of the Museum as an area of non-formal learning using innovative educational tools.
2. The creation of interdisciplinary courses related to History, Aesthetic Education and Geography, implemented then within the Museum, transforming it into a teaching classroom.

Dissemination activities throughout the implementation of the project will contribute to the transfer of learning outcomes to the wider educational community.



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
