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Erasmus+ “Integration of Museums into School Education 2nd L.T.T. Activity in Piraeus

The second training activity, in which the Regional Directorate of Education participates, took place in Piraeus from 6 to 10 May 2019, under the framework of the Erasmus + KA201 project "Integration of Museums into School Education" (2018-1-TR01-CA201-059698).

Representatives of the participating organizations in the project and teachers from Turkey, Slovenia, Poland, Italy and Greece met and worked together with teachers from the 5th Gymnasium of Ioannina.

The aim of the meeting was to design and present interdisciplinary teaching scenarios, based on the principles of discovery and experiential learning that promote the active participation of students. The participating teachers should implement the above lesson plans in museum settings and places of cultural interest as alternative learning environments and natural extension of the classroom.

The 32 participants had initially the opportunity of a theoretical approach to design a successful cross-curricular lesson combining three subjects: History, Geography and Aesthetics Education.

They attended the development of cross-curricular lesson plans as well as their on-spot implementation at places of cultural interest such as the Ancient Theater of Dionysos, the Daphni Monastery in Athens and the Poseidon Temple in Sounio.

The transnational group of participants also visited the Acropolis and the Acropolis museum, the Cultural and Spiritual Foundation Aikaterini Laskaridis, and the Hellenic Maritime Museum in Piraeus. Finally, they gathered information concerning the educational programs realized in the museums mentioned.
