



The Third Transnational Meeting of the Erasmus project: "Integration of Museums into School Education" (2018-1-TR01-KA201-059698), in the implementation activities of which the Regional Directorate of Education of Epirus participates in, was successfully completed at the museum "Diosecano e del Codex" in Rossano, Southern Italy, on 11 and 12 February 2020.

During the meeting, the representatives of the organizations participating in the project presented pilot interdisciplinary courses in museums and open public spaces of cultural interest. The courses were designed and implemented by History, Geography and Art teachers who teach in schools that have joined the project as associated partners.

From the part of the Regional Directorate of Education of Epirus, the 5th Gymnasium of Ioannina is the school which has undertaken the implementation of educational scenarios in museum settings and in open air environment.

In the meeting there was also discussed the results of all the activities carried out in each country until the beginning of February, but also those that will follow, such as the creation of a "museum corner" in each school and the planned activities of dissemination among the educational community of each country.

The representatives from the five other countries (Greece, Spain, Poland, Slovenia, and Turkey) were warmly welcomed at the "Scuola media Statale Carlo Levi" in Rossano by the Italian teachers who presented along with their students the activities implemented in the framework of the project.

The guided tour at the "Diosecano e del Codex" museum in the old town of Rossano which was particularly interesting, enhance the importance of strengthening the bond between school and museum.
